Following that, we will be learning about World War 2 for our history unit. We will learn lots about specific battles and how the war impacted on Britain.







### **Maths**

This half term we will be learning about place value and the four operations (addition, subtraction, division and multiplication).

You can help your child at home by providing them with numbers up to 5 digits to add and subtract as well as ensuring they know their times tables facts up 12 x 12 including the division facts as well.
