

Dear Parents / Carers,





I would like to reassure you that the safety of the children in our care is our utmost importance and this is why we have been overly cautious in our response.

Last Thursday, a full investigation was carried out by Public Health England (PHE), the Local Authority and the Trust. The outcome was that we could safely bring back all children and staff that have not been in direct contact with the two staff that have tested positive which is why the majority of children have now returned. They also looked closely at the control measures in place and could make no further recommendations to implement in school. Throughout the pandemic, we have followed all Government guidance and will continue to do so in the forthcoming months.

Face coverings

The wearing of masks in school is not recommended for children of primary school age. We have consulted with PHE and asked whether wearing a mask would have prevented the bubble from having to isolate. They have confirmed that regardless of whether the staff had a mask on or not, the outcome would still have been the same, I have attached a frequently asked questions sheet for your information.

The safety measures we have in place are as follows:

Staggered start times - Help us to keep our school community safe. Please bring your child to school at the correct time. **DO NOT** congregate in the playground and remain socially distanced from other parents and school staff.

A one way system - Please follow the one way system at all times. Enter school by the gate on Ryder Brow (yellow gate) and exit the playground by the gate on Old Hall Drive.

Year group bubbles - All children are in a year group bubbles and do not mix with anyone outside of their bubble. Each bubble has their own playtime and lunchtime in a designated area of the playground or MUGA.

Increased handwashing - All children and staff are washing their hands on entry and exit to the building and more frequently throughout the school day.

Social distancing - All staff have been asked to socially distance at all times throughout the school day.
